Background

The Max Planck Society suggests storing all primary data used in publications for at least ten years on durable and secure media.

To verify published work of MPI Magdeburg - also after a long period of time – the directors of the institute has decided to proceed in the following way:

Files to be stored

- experimental data, explanations to used measurement methods
- equations of mathematical models in a machine indedpendent manner, e.g. using MATLAB*.m ASCII files. This also includes parameters and initial conditions.
- Simulation results; if model parameters are fitted, the experimental data used must be stored
- Information on numerical tools and methods (types of integrators and solvers, output step size, tolerances)
- Description of newly developed algorithms

Basic structure of the CD-R/DVD


Please create the following directories:

1. Form, text-file of the published paper (pdf*), figures, tables.

*if possible please take the postprint of the article (this is the file AFTER the peer review but WITHOUT PUBLISHER LAYOUT

- 2. Material and Methods for the experimental data
- 3. Material and Methods for the simulation data.

Every directory should have a README File with a short documentation.



• Workflow

- Please fill in the form "archive CD/DVD" which you will find on the libraries web site (-> *publication services*)
- 2. Save the filled form as README on a CD-R which you will get from the library. If a CD or DVD is too small to store your data please contact me. There will be a possibility to store your data in a special directory.
- 3. Save all files which are important for the work as described before. Please save the **last (peer reviewed) version without publisher layout** of your paper as POSTPRINT.
- Print out the filled form, sign it and submit it together with the CD-R/DVD to the head of your research group for signature.
- 5. The secretary submit the signed form together with the CD-R/DVD to the library where the data will be registered for the archive.




